

Title: Police Senior User

Base: Flexible but regular travel required

Grade: Inspector

**Reports to:** Deputy Senior Responsible Officer (DSRO)

**Description:** As the Police Subject Matter Advisor for the JESIP team, you will be a serving Police Officer who will provide professional advice to Emergency Service colleagues in the continued drive to integrate and embed JESIP into Emergency Services business as usual arrangements.

## Key objectives and responsibilities will include:

- Providing advice on Police matters.
- Undertake the lead role for a specific JESIP workstream as and when required
- Assist with the delivery of the Joint Organisational Learning arrangements
- Working with partners, contribute to the development of sustainable Testing & Exercising arrangements, including the embedding of such arrangements into services Business as usual activities and to agreed standards.
- Working with partners, contribute to the development of future training requirements, including the creation of new training products and the associated delivery method for these.
- Continue to ensure alignment of single service doctrine with JESIP principles through development and implementation of the of self-assessment tools to support compliance with JESIP doctrine
- Provide support to local services and Local Resilience Forums to deliver on (existing) obligations e.g. exercise 'toolkit', multi-agency exercise calendar.
- Continue to work with national/specialist exercise teams so that interoperability objectives are incorporated as a matter of course into exercising.
- Work with professional organisations to ensure that single service/multiagency debrief reports are submitted on to the JOL Online system as soon as is practicably possible.
- Ensure effective Communications with LRF partners so that they are bought into the JOL online process, and provide targeted support to those that are difficult to engage.
- Provide information to the Governance Boards in the form of verbal updates or written papers, identifying where decisions or action needs to be taken at Board level
- Liaise with devolved administrations to ensure appropriate support for embedding activities.
- This role will require regular national travel
